

Fence construction - homeowners must complete an Architectural Change Request Form. To speed up the approval process, please consider these guidelines.

If building a wooden fence:

Posts must be of treated wood and set in concrete

Horizontal rails between posts must be of treated wood

Vertical pickets should be between 4-6" tall and must not be made of soft wood (such as pine) to prevent warping. Cedar is recommended.

It is recommended that vertical pickets not be in contact with the ground, to prevent rot/termites and to allow for easier trimming.

If considering non-wood building material for fence:

Chain link fencing will not be approved

Other metal fencing will be evaluated on a case by case basis

Most fences in Autumn Ridge are 5' tall shadow box design with cedar wood pickets. This is the preferred fence type for consistency throughout the neighborhood, though this style is not explicitly required.
