

Homestead Woods Homes Association COVID-19 Pool Reopening Process

The Board of Directors of Homestead Woods Homes Association is working to reopen the association pool in a responsible manner. We are committed to following all federal, state, county and municipal rules and recommendations. That being said, they are subject to frequent change. We urge all members to monitor the Homestead Woods neighbors website for the latest information regarding pool rules.

The Board of Directors for Homestead Woods cannot guarantee this pool is free of the novel coronavirus. By using the pool you are assuming the risk that you may contract the virus.

During the early stages of reopening, the association requires residents to comply with the limits on the number of attendees that can be present at the facility. Homestead Woods bathers capacity/occupancy limit is **40**. This number is also subject to change. In addition, the association recommends:

- Do not come to or use the pool if you or a family member has a fever or are experiencing any other COVID-19 symptoms
- Shower at home prior to entering the pool facility
- Maximize social distancing (6 foot minimum)
- Masks are encouraged when not in water
- Wash hands frequently
- No guests - HOMESTEAD WOODS RESIDENTS ONLY (until further notice)
- No parties allowed
- Bring wipes and hand sanitizer to assist in disinfecting areas that you use (Pool furniture is to be used at your own risk. It will NOT be disinfected daily)
- Chairs have been removed or distanced 6 feet apart - Please maintain unless with immediate family
- Lost and Found will not be available this pool season (if anything is left after the pool closes, it will be thrown away)

IF RESIDENTS DO NOT WORK TOGETHER TO RESPECT EACH OTHER'S ABILITY TO SOCIALLY DISTANCE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CLOSE THE POOL.

Please be respectful of other members. Consider other families and limit your family's time at the pool. Maintain social distance. Be safe!
