Here are a few reasons for the review:

- Home values are struggling in this economy. But when your home is for sale, potential buyers will look not only at *your* home, but also at the neighborhood. In general, houses in neighborhoods with a more uniform appearance command a higher price.
- It protects you from future claims that the change was not authorized or approved. Neighbors change, board members change, and opinions may change. But a documented and approved ACC form gets filed in the HOA *permanent* records.
- When it comes down to it, we all agreed to the ACC review process in the deeds to our homes in Amber Hills Estates. It was a commitment to each other as a neighborhood.

The "Architectural Review" process is easily initiated from the home page for Amber Hill Estates at <u>www.eneighbors.com</u>. On the left side, there is a link for "Architectural Review". Clicking that link will launch a page that contains an online form that can be filled out and submitted by pressing a button. You can even attach documents to support the review, such as sketches, plans, photos or pdf's. When you submit that form, it will trigger an e-mail to the ACC for review. You can also print and manually complete a hard-copy form. A link to our standard printable form is also available on the "Architectural Review" page.

We will make a goal of getting the form back to you within a week, unless special circumstances require extra consideration or a quicker response. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.
