## Roofing Replacement Guidelines

This Specification covers acceptable materials for use in the replacement of roofs of all single family homes within the Wellington Park Homes Association.

Acceptable materials for roofs shall be:

## A. Wood Shakes:

- 1. Number 1 or 2 grade
- 2. Minimum ½" thickness measured at butt of shingle
- B. Laminated Composition Shingles:
  - 1. Architectural shingle with shadow lines and or relief imitating wood shakes.
  - 2. Required to be installed with preformed ridge shingles similar to *Elk Prestique Plus* or *Owens Corning Oakridge series*.
  - 3. Shall have the appearance and color range of natural weathered cedar shingles or cedar shakes.
  - 4. Required to be U.L. Class A fire rated material.
  - 5. Required that the contractor install in accordance with the manufacturers recommendation for the selected type of material used.

All other roof materials are subject to approva	al on an individual case basis by the Architectural
Control Committee (ARC). Replacement roof	requests for all other roofing materials shall have
an appearance and quality consistent with the	wood shake or laminated composition shingle
guidelines.
