Residents at One Park Place are asked to bring all recycled items to the Trash Room on the Garden Level as you step off the back door of the service elevator. The green totes are for you to put your items in. All recycles are taken to the dock area by Monday morning for pick up.

Below is a list of all recyclables and how they are to be handled. Please review the list of items that can and cannot be recycled in our CoMingle totes.

Items That Can Be Recycled

Newspaper
Catalogs
Ad Inserts
Magazines
Phone Books
Brochures
Office Paper
Manila Folders
Junk Mail
Carrier Stock (soft drink & beer cartons)
Chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe & gift boxes, etc.)
Aluminum & Tin Cans
#1 Pet Plastic (soft drink bottles, water bottles, etc.) Lids need to be removed.
Plastics #5-6 Tins
Shredded paper (only if it is clear bagged)

- Please empty & rinse all containers
- Labels are okay
- Flatten large plastic bottles

Items That Cannot Be Recycled

Trash
Books (hardback & paperback)
Gift Wrap or Blueprints
Photographs or Carbon Paper
Plastic Bags or String
Plastic Sheet Material
Frozen Food Containers
Egg Cartons
Paper Cups & Plates
Pet Food, Kitty Litter, Fertilizer or Charcoal Bags
Dark or Fluorescent Paper
Tissues or Paper Towels
Scrap Metals
Plastic Toys
Vitamin or Prescription Bottles
Motor Oil Bottles
Film Canisters
6-Pack Holders
Automotive Product Bottles
Batteries
GLASS (including light bulbs)
Styrofoam
PVC Pipe
Cardboard (requires separate container)
