HOA Dues & Billing

- Annual dues are assessed each March and cover maintenance of common areas, landscaping, insurance, pool, trash, and other community services.
- You should receive your first dues invoice in March of each year. Payments can be made online via a QuickBooks link that will be in the invoice.
- Starting in 2026, we will no longer accept checks for dues.

Trash & Recycling Pickup

- Our trash company is Gardner Disposal. You can find all holiday schedules, sign up for alerts, and view recycling allowables at <u>Gardner Disposal</u>.
- Trash is collected every Monday, along with recycling and yard waste.
- Please place bins and yard waste at the curb by 7:00 AM on collection days (bins should be removed from the curb by nighttime).
- Yard waste runs from your first pick-up in March through your last pick-up in December. There is an 8-item weekly limit. Overage stickers can be purchased by contacting Gardner Disposal.
- Bulky-item pickup occurs once a year in fall. Once we get the dates, it will be communicated via eNeighbors.

Architectural & Landscaping Standards

- Any exterior modifications (fences, siding, paint, etc.) require prior approval from the Architectural Review Committee (ARC). An ARC application form can be completed on eNeighbors.
- Front-yard landscaping should be maintained and weed-free to keep our streets looking neat. Grass should be mowed at least once every two weeks during the growing season, and hedges/trees trimmed to avoid sidewalks or street encroachment.

Parking & Vehicles

- On-street parking is allowed, but please avoid blocking sidewalks, mailboxes, or fire hydrants.
- RVs, boats, and trailers may only be parked in driveways (not on the street) for a maximum of 48 hours.

Pet Policies

- Pets must be kept on a leash when outside your fenced yard.
- Please clean up after your pets immediately. Do not throw pet waste into neighbors' trash bins.
- Cats and dogs must be registered through the city. More information is in the city links below.
- The city enforces excessive barking under their noise ordinance. Please be respectful of your neighbors and do not leave barking dogs outside.

Pool Key

- Our neighborhood pool has a key entry. You should have received your key from the previous owner. If not, please email Ali Jones (President) at <u>ali@simplyjones.net</u> to complete the pool rules form and get your key.
