

Absentee Ballots

Absentee ballots for the election of Board Members are available to all unit owners who are out of town or cannot attend the meeting for reasons beyond their control. Absentee ballots can be requested from Centennial Management at least three days prior to the Annual Association Meeting. Requested ballots will be emailed (if homeowner provides email address to Centennial Management) or sent by mail to the homeowner upon request. You can also obtain an absentee ballot by downloading one from our website on eNeighbors.com.

Please complete the form and seal it in an envelope. Sign across the flap of the envelope and place the date below. On the front of the envelope, print your name at the bottom right. (This will not be opened until the ballot counters open it.) Please give the envelope to the Association Secretary or put it in the mail drop at the clubhouse. All ballots must be received before start of the Annual Meeting.

Proxies

Proxies are available to all unit owners who are unable to attend the Annual Meeting. Proxies can be requested from Centennial Management at least three days prior to the Annual Association Meeting. Requested proxies will be emailed (if homeowner provides email address to Centennial Management) or sent by mail to the homeowner upon request.

Completed Proxies must be dated, signed and delivered to whomever you wish to designate as your proxy voter. A proxy must be brought to the meeting for verification by a Centennial Management representative prior to any vote that is called for at the Annual Meeting. You can also obtain a proxy by downloading one from our website on eNeighbors.com.

It is our intent that absentee ballots be used for voting. A proxy ballot can also be used for other, unexpected business that might come up during the meeting, including any change or addition to the slate of candidates.
