

## **Springlake Village eNeighbors Guide**

- The two main purposes of this site are (a) to digitize the hospitality committee-sponsored events and (b) to revive the pre-Covid sense of community.
- An additional purpose of this site is to have a way to communicate (“posting”) with other neighbors without calling, texting, or e-mailing them directly.
- A post may be reviewed for content to determine whether it violates this guide.
- Although this is an informal forum, it will be subject to all applicable laws and governing documents.
- Owners are expected to maintain proper on-line behavior and decorum.
- The following Do’s and Don’ts may be modified from time to time:

### **DO:**

- Be respectful to and of others.
- Use this site as a means to contribute positively to the community.
- If you disagree with a post, find a respectful way to explain how and why.
- Differentiate statements of opinion from statements of fact.
- Be protective of private personal information.
- Privately contact the moderator or a board member if one of your posts is removed to ask why.
- Generally, avoid controversial topics as you would if you were attending one of our social events. However, if you are so inclined, asking for (or offering) prayers when a neighbor is sick or has passed away will not be considered “controversial.”

### **DON’T:**

- Don’t be negative.
- Don’t spread false information.
- Don’t be rude to, or disrespectful of, your neighbor.
- Don’t violate the eNeighbors’ “Content Moderation and Disagreements” standards or its “Terms of Use.”
